"Pulled-Venison" Sandwiches

- Ingredients
- 1 boneless venison roast (4 pounds)
 - 1-1/2 cups ketchup
 - 3 tablespoons brown sugar
 - 1 tablespoon ground mustard
 - 1 tablespoon lemon juice
 - 1 tablespoon soy sauce
 - 1 tablespoon liquid smoke, optional
 - 2 teaspoons celery salt
 - 2 teaspoons pepper
 - 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
 - 1 teaspoon onion powder
 - 1 teaspoon garlic powder
 - 1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg
 - 3 drops hot pepper sauce
 - 14 to 18 hamburger buns, split



TOTAL TIME: Prep: 15 min. Cook:
8 hours YIELD: 14-18 servings

Directions

1. Cut venison roast in half; place in a 5-qt. slow cooker. In a large bowl, combine the ketchup, brown sugar, mustard, lemon juice, soy sauce, liquid smoke if desired and seasonings. Pour over venison. Cover and cook on low for 8-10 hours or until meat is tender.
2. Remove roast; cool slightly. Shred meat with two forks; return to slow cooker and heat through. Using a slotted spoon, place meat mixture on bun bottoms. Replace tops. Yield: 14-18 servings.
